## Curriculum

### Writing

Students are learning to write with concise and clear main ideas and include elaborate detail in their work by using detail generating questions such as; What does it look like? Why is it important? They are also learning to write powerful supporting details for their expository pieces.

### Bible Memory Work

I John 1:9 “If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. “

### Reading

Students will be working with specific reading strategies such as self monitoring, making connections and analyzing.

### Math

We are working on our study of multiplication and division. The next unit of study will be data management. We will collect, display and analyze data to solve problems, looking at first hand data, second hand data, and double bar graphs. Please continue practicing multiplication facts at home!

### Science

Electricity and Magnetism is the unit of study in 5TJ. 5H and 5V are currently working through the Grade 5 Chemistry unit.

### Social Studies

The students are beginning the study of Canada’s history. We will be looking at the lives of the First Nations people before European exploration and settlement.

**Bible** - We are continuing our study of Jesus’ miracles, learning about being a Kingdom Kid, as well as focussing on Advent.
